We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER), which provides key information on the 2022-23 educational progress for Summerfield Elementary. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. For the 2023-24 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the, Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2022-23. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2021-22. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or had a graduation rate at or below 67% in 2021-22. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school was identified as having not been given any of these labels.

There is only one elementary school within the district where all elementary-aged students attend. Every spring, parents have the opportunity to submit their child's educational needs in writing so they can be matched with the best teacher to meet their needs.

Our school improvement plan is in the second year of a five-year plan. The focus of our plan is on increasing student achievement in all content areas with a hyper-focus on literacy and math. Our curriculum is aligned with the Michigan State Standards that can be accessed on the Michigan Department of Education website.

We are also working on meeting the social-emotional needs of our students. We are targeting this area with individuals, small groups, and large groups. It is our belief that meeting these needs will, in turn, increase student achievement.

Parent-teacher conferences are held twice a year with 90% attendance. As always, we are committed to providing a quality education for Summerfield students. Parents and community members are welcome to view our school improvement plan, visit our school, and are encouraged to be active in our school.

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The Summerfield teachers and staff are continually working to meet the needs of all students and prepare them for their future. Each year may bring unique successes and challenges. Our staff is committed to consistently looking at our data to make sure that student achievement in academics, as well as social-emotional growth, is being strengthened.
